

# TOWN OF CLAREMONT

## AMENDMENT TO LOCAL LAW RELATING TO SIGNS

That under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995* (the Act) and under all the powers enabling it, the Council of the Town of Claremont resolves on 2008 to amend the Local Law Relating to Signs which was published in the Government Gazette on 15 March 2000 and amended on 13 October 2000 and 29 December 2000 and to proceed with amending the Local Law in accordance with Section 3.12 of the Act as follows:

1. In clause 13.1 delete “A” at the beginning of the sentence and insert the words “Subject to clause 13.2, a”
2. Insert a new clause 13.2 as follows:

“13.2 Notwithstanding clause 13.1.1, Council may approve an application for a licence in respect of a sign that:

(i) is located within the Town Centre Zone as delineated in the Town of Claremont Town Planning Scheme No.3 and complies with the requirements included in the Town of Claremont Policy 102 – Town Centre Zone Signage Policy;

(ii) is located within the Town Centre and

- is not of a type specifically mentioned in either the Town of Claremont Policy 102 – Town Centre Zone Signage Policy and Division 4; or
- does not comply with a requirement stipulated in the Town of Claremont Policy 102 – Town Centre Zone Signage Policy or in Division 4

provided it considers the application to be consistent with all the policy objectives of the Town of Claremont Policy 102 – Town Centre Zone Signage Policy.”

2. Insert a new definition in clause 5.1 as follows:

““Town Centre Zone” means the Town Centre Zone as delineated in the Town of Claremont Town Planning Scheme No.3”
