PLASTIC

All plastic containers are acceptable.

Milk, icecream, juice, drink, butter, margarine, yogurt, flower pots, and liquid detergent containers (washed) are all suitable for recycling, as well as any plastic container coded



Plastic chemical, cosmetic or petrol containers are non-recyclable.

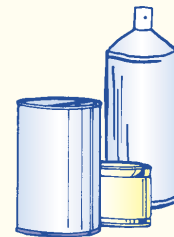


GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

No porcelain. No china. No window glass. No broken glass.



ALUMINIUM CANS, CLEAN FOIL & FOIL TRAYS

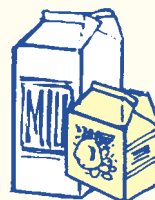


STEEL/TIN CANS

Wash containers. Includes aerosol cans.



CLEAN NEWSPAPERS, GLOSSY INSERTS & MAGAZINES



MILK & JUICE WAXED CARTONS

Rinse out and squash flat.



ALL CARDBOARD

Cardboard sheets, boxes, cereal packaging and food boxes.

DISCARDED CLOTHES & SOFT TOYS FOR RE-USE ONLY

Should be placed in a bag and then in the recycling bin. These will be handed on to charity organisations



non-recyclables

- Garden refuse
- Batteries
- Shrink wrap, bread bags, plastic shopping bags etc.
- Liquid of any kind
- Polystyrene containers e.g. meat trays
- Household food waste
