

Town of Claremont Art Award & Exhibition 2019

Terms and Conditions of Entry



Entries must be received by 5pm Friday 19 July 2019. Entry to the Art Award is to be registered online at <https://www.trybooking.com/BCLTU>

Registration is a two-step process. Once booking has been made, a photo of the work will need to be submitted via email to toc@claremont.wa.gov.au

There is a \$20 non refundable administration fee to enter the Art Award, payable at the point of registration.

Prizes for this award:

- First Prize \$5000
- Second Prize \$2500
- Third Prize \$1500
- Claremont Local Award \$500
- People's Choice Award \$500

The 2019 Art Awards and Exhibition will be held at the Town of Claremont administration building – 308 Stirling Highway, Claremont.

Entering artists must be age 16+.

Town of Claremont employees, Elected Members and family members are ineligible to enter.

The 'Claremont Local Award' category is open to any current resident of the Town of Claremont.

Artists must reside in Western Australia. Each entrant may submit one work only. Work must be original and completed after July 2018.

3 Dimensional works must be displayed on an independent base (supplied by the artist). They must not exceed a height of 1.6m and the base footprint must not exceed 500mm x 500mm.

2 Dimensional works must not exceed 1.3m x 1.3m in any direction including frame. Any work over these dimensions, in fairness to other exhibitors, will not be accepted.

Accepted Mediums:

- Acrylic
- Mixed Media
- Oil
- Pastel
- Print
- Textile
- Watercolor
- Work on Paper

Artists of works selected will be notified via email on Wednesday 7 August 2019.

If you are contacted, works must be delivered on Sunday 25 August between 9am and 12pm to Town of Claremont Building, 308 Stirling Hwy, Claremont, 6010. Failure to do so will result in works not being judged or displayed.

Town of Claremont will appoint up to four judges to select the winners of the Awards. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence or conversation will be entered into.

Judging will take place on Thursday 29 August. The 'People's Choice Award' will be voted for during the Exhibition.

The judges' selection will be based on the following criteria:

- A demonstrated high level of technical skill, creativity and originality.
- Reflective of Claremont, an established, socially conscious and well-informed community
- Responsive to or inspired by the cultural identity, character and community of the Town
- Diverse in art forms and approach

From the images submitted, up to 65 framed works and 15 sculptures will be selected judged and displayed at the Exhibition. Please note that the Town of Claremont will endeavor to hang work to a professional standard but, as part of a group show, your work may not be displayed to individual specifications.

Works will automatically be entered into the People's Choice Award. Where applicable, works will also be entered automatically into the Claremont Local Award.

All works selected for the exhibition must be for sale. Sale price must include a 20% commission + GST if applicable.

Works must be delivered suitably presented and ready for display/hanging (i.e. dry and properly affixed with D-rings, cord or wire to hold weight of work). Further information will be provided to the artists selected for the Awards.

The Award Announcements and Exhibition Opening will take place on Friday 30 August, 6pm-8pm, at the Town of Claremont Council building, 308 Stirling Hwy, Claremont, 6010.

Each exhibiting artist will receive an invitation to attend and a plus one.

The Town of Claremont will act as an agent on behalf of the artist for any sale of artworks, and will collect 20% commission on the sale of artworks in the exhibition.

At the conclusion of the exhibition, unsold works are to be collected Sunday 15 September between 12pm and 3pm from, Town of Claremont Council building, 308 Stirling Hwy, Claremont, 6010. Works not collected on Sunday 15 September will become the property of the Town of Claremont.

Town of Claremont will not accept responsibility for the visual representation/ interpretation of any works. It is the artist's responsibility to ensure that his/her work is not subject to libel, defamation of character or in violation of copyright laws.

The artist agrees to allow any work to be reproduced in part or whole by print or electronic media only for promotion of the Art Awards and the Town of Claremont. Copyright remains the property of the artist.

Works will not be covered by Town of Claremont insurance. Town of Claremont will take all reasonable care, however, cannot accept responsibility for damage, loss, fire, theft or vandalism. Artists are advised to provide their own insurance.

Artists will receive payment by Friday 11 October 2019 for any works sold.
