#### 3 GENERAL BUSINESS

#### 3.1 2016-17 TOWN OF CLAREMONT ANNUAL REPORT

The <u>2016-17 Town of Claremont Annual Report</u> ('Annual Report') was adopted by Council on 21 November 2017.

The Annual Report summarises the achievements of the Town during the 2016-17 financial year and includes a report from the Mayor and Chief Executive Officer, the financial report and Auditor's report for the period, and all matters prescribed in the *Local Governance Act 1995 (The Act)*.

The Act requires Local Government authorities to hold an Annual Electors' Meeting of Council once a year, no later than 56 days after Council adopts the Annual Report.

Matters to be discussed at the Annual Electors' Meeting are the content of the Annual Report for the previous financial year, and other general business.

#### Reports of the Mayor, Chief Executive Officer and review of outcomes (4-28)

This section of the Annual Report addresses the more significant outcomes achieved during the financial year with five focus areas of Council being: Liveability, Prosperity, People, Environment and Leadership and Governance.

#### Auditor's Report (29-31)

The 2016-17 Auditor's Report has detailed their opinion within their Report, which indicated:

- Financial Reports have been completed in accordance with the Local Government Act 1995, Regulations and Australian Accounting Standards.
- Provide a fair view of the Town's financial position as at 30 June 2017.
- Confirm no matters indicating significant adverse trends in financial position or Management of the Town.
