

# Proposed Permanent Road Closure – Road Reserve Adjacent to 1 and 10 Links Court, Claremont

### What is being proposed?

The Town has received a request to permanently close portions of the road reserve adjoining 1 and 10 Links Court, Claremont to enable both properties to be used for future residential use.

Preliminary investigations confirm the two areas proposed for closure do not comprise any subdivided freehold lots and are zoned Residential under the Town's *Local Planning Scheme No. 3* (LPS3). They form part of the Links Court and Davies Road reservations. The sites contain limited vegetation or infrastructure and are not currently required for the Town's operational purposes.

## **Consultation period**

Submissions will be accepted from 5pm, Monday 3 November 2025.

## **Submission process**

After the close of the advertising period, the proposal and the submissions received will be considered at a future Council meeting.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### What happens next?

Advertising is in accordance with legislation, the Town will invite the public and agency submissions for a minimum of 35 days. After the consultation period, Council will consider all submissions before making a final recommendation to the Minister for Lands.



# Proposed Permanent Road Closure – Road Reserve Adjacent to 1 and 10 Links Court, Claremont

If the Minister supports the closure, the land becomes unallocated Crown land. Any disposal or transfer is subsequently managed by DPLH.

#### Where do the proceeds from the sale go?

Sale proceeds accrue to the State Government, not to the Town of Claremont, although the Town may recover administrative costs incurred.
