TIMED PARKING

Vehicles displaying the correct permit are exempt from the timed parking restrictions and can park within their precinct for **72 hours.**

Timed parking will operate from: Monday to Friday 8.30am - 5.30pm Saturday 8.30am -12pm Sunday - No restrictions

VERGE PARKING

The owner/occupier of a property may park or give permission to another party to park a vehicle on the verge of that property. Precinct parking relates to on-street parking only. If a vehicle is parked on your verge without your permission, please call Ranger Services 9285 4300.

SIGNAGE

Signage will be installed at the entry points to the street advising drivers they are entering a precinct. Line markings will be used to show areas where parking is allowed or restricted. The Town acknowledges that signage clutter is an issue and is working towards reducing the use of unnecessary signage.

WHY ARE WE CHANGING?

The Town has developed a new on-street parking plan to make it easier and faster to find a parking space within your neighbourhood. Demand for on-street parking has gradually grown with the increased development of residential units and commercial office space, expansion of private schools, health and aged care facilities. Community consultation undertaken in 2017 highlighted parking and dealing with peak traffic as priorities for the Town to focus on. The plan divides the Town into 7 precincts with parking requirements tailored specifically to the needs within each zone.

PARKING PERMITS

Parking permits are only required for residents who wish to park on streets with timed parking restrictions.

If there is no timed parking in your street then you do not require a parking permit.

To see if your street requires a parking permit, visit the Town's website at the address below.

Each single residential and group housing property is entitled to two parking permits. Parking permits will not be issued for multiple dwellings.

- Each permit is valid for 3 years.
- Residents can apply for additional parking permits, subject to the approval of the Town's CEO and fees will apply.
- Parking permits allow residents and their visitors to park for up to 72 hours.
- Permits do not allow drivers to park contrary to other restrictions and signage (e.g. no stopping, clearway, cycle lanes, continuous yellow lines, bus zones, loading zones, taxi bays, ACROD bays).
- Permits cannot be used for a vehicle that has a trailer or caravan attached.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications for parking permits must be made by the owner, not a tenant. The parking permit application form can be found on the Town's website: **www.claremont.wa.gov.au/ Services/Rangers-and-Community-Safety/Precinct-Parking**
